ORDER GRANTING DEFENDANT’S MOTION FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT


As previously scheduled in this Court’s Order of December 19, 2017, this cause came before the Court on March 28, 2018 for oral argument on the *Motion for Summary Judgment* filed by the sole remaining Defendant, Partners Management Company, LLC. Both parties were represented by counsel, with Kenneth M. Wilk arguing for the Plaintiff and Trevor W. Wells arguing for the Defendant. Having reviewed the parties’ written filings and designations of records, considered the arguments of counsel, and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Court now:

1. DETERMINES that it may properly exercise subject-matter jurisdiction regarding the Plaintiff’s claims asserted in this action because the Workers Compensation Act does not provide the exclusive remedy for the recovery Plaintiff seeks;

2. AND ORDERS that Defendant’s *Motion for Summary Judgment* is hereby GRANTED because the parties’ designations of record demonstrate that, although the Plaintiff had a good-faith basis to believe otherwise at the time he brought this action, discovery has demonstrated that there are no genuine issues of material fact as to any cause of action that could establish Defendant’s liability for the Plaintiff’s injuries. Accordingly, this cause is DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE.

Because this entry of summary judgment resolves all remaining pending claims as to all remaining parties in this cause, this is a final and appealable judgment.
